



Slovenia – Hungary

DECISIONS of the of the 6th Monitoring Committee Meeting of the Interreg Programme Slovenia-Hungary in the period 2021-2027 4-5 June 2025, Lenti, Hungary

DECISION 1

The members of the Monitoring Committee (MC) took note that the final documents of the CP V-A Slovenia-Hungary programme 2014-2020 were sent to the European Commission in April 2025.

DECISION 2

2.1 <u>The members of the MC decided to approve 9 projects</u>, 3 projects in the frame of priority 1 and 6 projects in the frame of priority 2.

The approved projects are the following:

Priority 1: BioGemTwin, AQUANATURE, KeepItDark

Priority 2: RE-ACTION, C4F-ELEVATE, CROSS-SACRAL, CULTIVINE, Kul-Well, GUČIMO

2.2 <u>The members of the MC decided to reject 11 projects</u>, 2 projects in the frame of priority 1, and 9 projects in the frame of priority 2.

The rejected projects are the following:

Priority 1: NBS for locals, Generation Forest

Priority 2: CAMINOSIHU, GENIUS, Mura-Kerka Naturland, FRUIT ROUTE, CULT-BRIDGE, ECO-SLOW,

Nature Experiences, MetAX, Green Treasures

DECISION 3

- 3.1 The MC agreed that the current Open Call for Proposals for standard projects will close. The Managing Authority/Joint Secretariat will prepare the revised Call for Proposals for adoption by the end of June 2025. The updated version of the Open Call will be submitted to the Bilateral Working Group for discussion and approval. Subsequently, the final documents will be circulated to MC members for approval via written procedure.
- 3.2 The newly adopted Open Call for standard projects, including the revised deadline as agreed with the MC members, will be published on the programme website in the autumn. The new deadline for the submission of project proposals will be set for January 2026.
- 3.3 The members of the MC agreed that the date for next, 7th MC meeting is foreseen to be taken approximately end of May 2026 or beginning of June 2026, depending on number of received project applications in the frame of the submission deadline.
