

“EVERYONE HAS A NEIGHBOUR”

CONTEST of INTERREG V-A AUSTRIA-HUNGARY, SLOVENIA-HUNGARY and SLOVENIA-AUSTRIA

Call for artworks

Interreg V-A Austria-Hungary (‘ATHU CP’) Slovenia-Hungary (‘SIHU CP’) and Slovenia-Austria (‘SIAT CP’), the Joint Secretariats (‘JS’) of ATHU CP, SIHU CP and SIAT CP announce an open call together for artworks in the framework of Interreg 30th anniversary’s “everyone has a neighbour” topic.

Aim of the Call

The aim of the present Call is to make the Interreg 30th anniversary and its objectives more visible, by animating and motivating the general public to identify their ideas, emotions, feelings towards the cross-border cooperation of Austrian Slovenian and Hungarian organisations, and share it with others through the publications (online) of the ATHU CP, SIHU CP and SIAT CP.

Subject of the Call

Artworks in any easy-to-publish format (e.g.: photos, videos, drawings, songs, etc.) are to be submitted.

Technical Specifications of artworks

Photos and drawings (if applicable) must be submitted as a high-resolution JPEG file (as high as your camera will allow), but minimum 350 dpi.

Songs and videos must be no longer than 2 minutes, and they must be submitted in an easy to publish format and in as high quality as the recording device allows.

Low quality images, songs and videos will not be subject of further assessment.

Participants in the Call

The Contest is open to all citizens. Participants under the age of 18 shall be able to demonstrate that their parent or guardian has given consent to their participation.

Submission of Artworks

Artworks must be received within the contest’s duration time between 17.08.2020 and 17.09.2020.

Artworks should be submitted via an online application form which is available on the SIHU CP official webpage: <http://www.si-hu.eu/en2/everyone-has-a-neighbour/>

The attached files shall be labelled with the Participant’s surname, abbreviation of the country of origin and if needed, the number of the artwork, divided by bottom lines. (E.g. the Participant’s name is Peter Sample from Slovenia, submits 3 artworks, the filenames shall be Sample_SI_01.jpeg for the first artwork, Sample_SI_02.jpeg for the second artwork and so on.)

Selection of Winners, Prizes

6 winners will be announced. Artworks will be judged on adherence to its message clarity, composition and overall presentation, and the most well composed, artistic work that evoke the best interpretation of the “everyone has a neighbour” topic. For 3 of 6 the ATHU CP JS, SIHU CP JS and SIAT CP JS will be the jury, whose decision is final. For choosing the other 3 winners, general public will be involved, and will judge the works during the European Cooperation week - starting with 21st September 2020 - on the Facebook pages of the Programmes. The social media round starts 21st September 2020 and lasts until 25th September 2020. Winners will be announced in 2 rounds. The 3 winners chosen by the Programmes will be announced on 18th September 2020, the general public’s 3 favourites will be announced on the week after the European Cooperation week – on the 28th September 2020 - and will

be posted on the ATHU, SIHU and SIAT CP official webpage. The winning Creators will be notified by e-mail.

Each winner will be awarded ATHU, SIHU and SIAT CP promotional items and/or outdoor experiences offered by the co-financed projects. The prizes cannot be exchanged or transferred by the winners and cannot be redeemed by them for cash or any other prize.
